Showcasing above treeline intermediate terrain with awe-inspiring views of Mother Nature be your guide through bowls and tranquil trees, or feel the

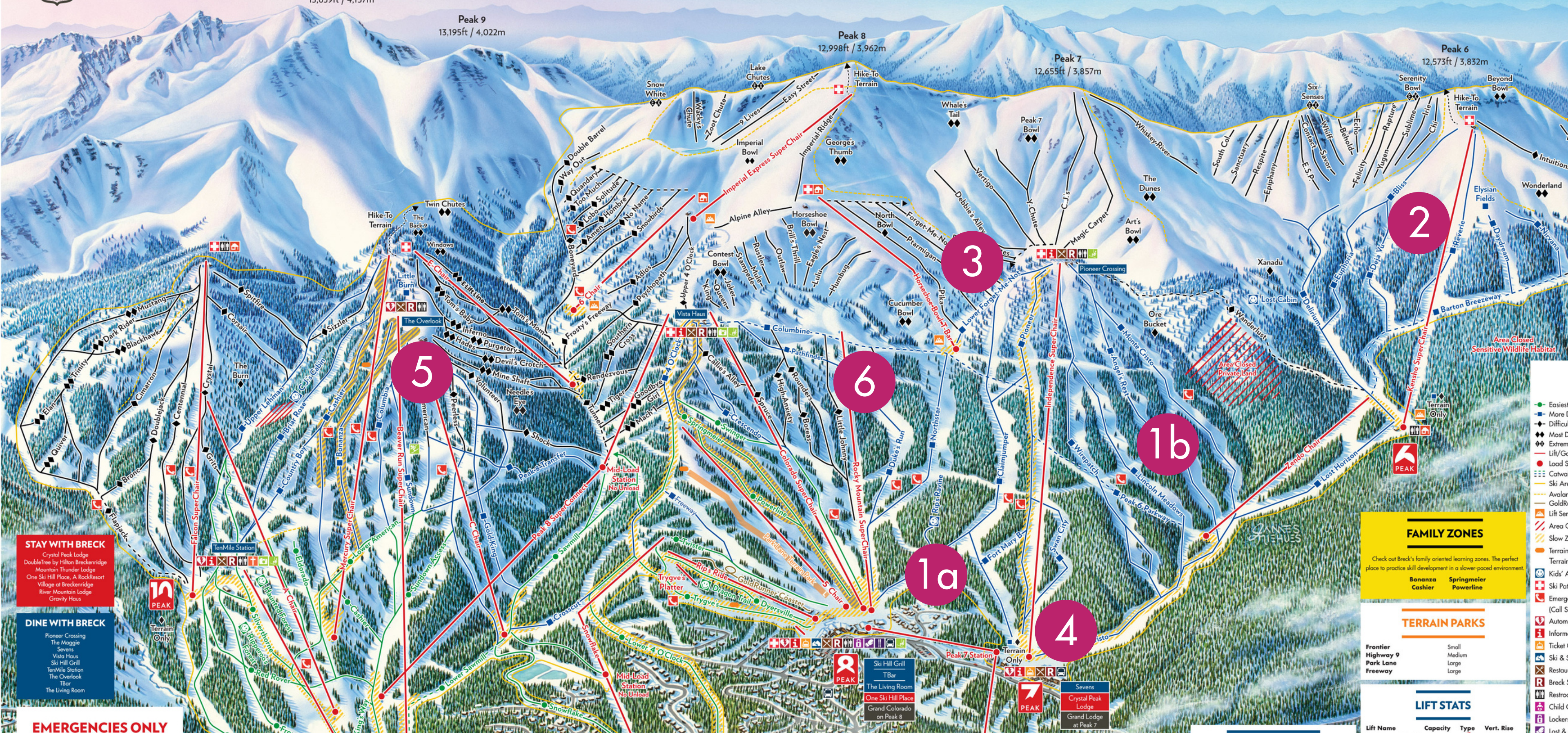
